DESCRIPTION

This dual master's-level CEU program will familiarize participants with Catholic teaching on the apostolic mission of the Church, stewardship, and the dignity of work, while highlighting presuppositions that may differ from those in their previous work environments. Participants will be offered resources to empower them in fulfilling their role in building the Kingdom of God.

OUTCOMES

- Define core Catholic Church terminology, explain its hierarchical governance structure, and describe basic administrative functions at the parish and diocesan levels.
- Exhibit a familiarity with Canon Law as it pertains to HR administration.
- Apply Gospel values in one's HR role.
- Utilize Catholic social doctrine when developing policies and procedures and other HR initiatives and projects.
- Understand the unique application of HR principles in the church workplace.

FORMAT

- It is anticipated that this course can be completed in 22 hours.
- Six, two-hour, live, virtual sessions
 - Includes 30-minute structured discussion with the instructor.
 - Sessions followed by discussion boards and assigned readings. Presenters will respond to questions from participants.
- Final assignment due **April 9**
- If desired, participants, will be assigned a mentor from January–April 2027.
